### **Purpose of Job:**

Assisting the team leader in identifying and meeting camper needs and carrying out camp activities.

Accountabilities: You will be accountable for, but not limited to:

#### **Essential Job Functions**

- Knowing the campers in your unit and helping them learn to respect the rights of others and to understand the differences and similarities of other campers.
- Assist the team leader in guiding activities and experiences through the use of the Experiential Learning Cycle
- Follow all American Camp Association standards (as trained).
- Assist the team leader in coordinating activities with program directors and area specialists.
- Ensuring timely rotation through camp activities as scheduled.
- Assisting with housekeeping, sanitation, care of supplies and equipment.
- Assisting with daily before and after camp responsibilities as needed and scheduled.

#### General

- Observing camper behavior and assisting the team leader in assessing its appropriateness, enforcing appropriate safety regulations and emergency procedures, and applying appropriate behavior management techniques.
- Eating with children and supervising clean up, assisting with before and after meal activities.
- Providing written requests for any time off needed.
- Assisting with initial and end of season inventory and store equipment for safety.
- Evaluating current season and making suggestions for the following season.
- Other duties as assigned.

#### **Desired Qualifications**

- Be at least 16 years of age.
- Be committed to the implementation of managing diversity and have the ability to work with people of diverse backgrounds and abilities.
- Current American Red Cross First Aid/CPR certification (training offered on site).
- Ability to communicate and work with campers ages 7-14 and provides necessary verbal instruction to campers.
- Visual auditory ability to identify and respond to environmental and other hazards related to the activity.
